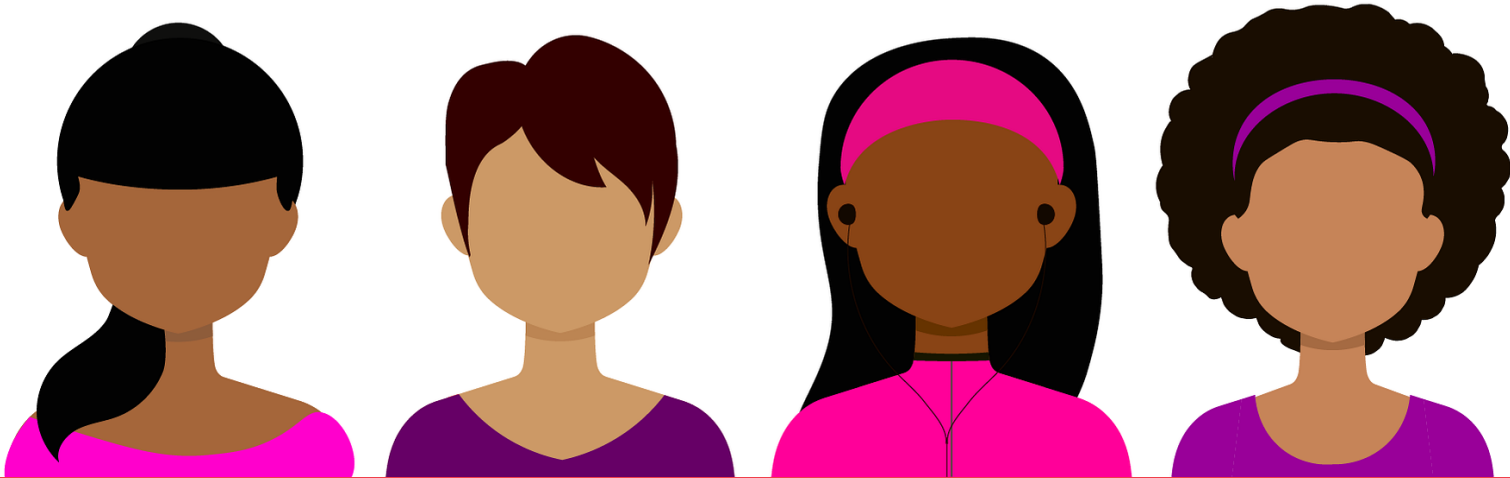


# Y Connect Program
